Hello Washington School, Grizzly Hill School, new families and community members,

Here is the latest information for week four.

In observance of Labor Day, there is no school tomorrow, Monday, September 7th, 2020.

As most of you may know, our geographic area is under a PG&E Public Safety Power Shutoff watch. I believe our area shows a possible shut off tomorrow night at 9pm.

If our power stays on, our plan is as follows:

Resume remote classes on Tuesday.

Wednesday will be Robotics from 10-10:45 and again from 1:00-1:45. These introductory classes are taught by the district's administrative assistant, Sunshine Bender. Sunshine worked many hours this summer to put together a robotics elective program for when our students return to class. These 45 minute sessions will be an introduction to **OzoBots**. You must reserve a spot as we can only accommodate 8 students in each class. Please call the main office: 265-9052.

Also on Wednesday, HotSpot distribution and ChromeBook basics classes, again from Sunshine Bender, will be from 11:00-11:45 and 2:00-2:45. If you cannot make a Wednesday pick up, we will accommodate another day/time. We are happy to get them out to all our students in need. Have a question, call 265-9052.

If we have no power on Tuesday there will be no classes that day and the district will make decisions on a day to day basis. Not having classes will be tough for everyone but we've come this far, we are already in week four, and as a school community we've shown strength and resilience through these past six months.
