NOTIFICATION OF PLANNED PESTICIDE USE
FOR THE 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR**

Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Healthy Schools Act of 2000 requires all California school districts to notify parents and guardians of pesticides they expect to apply during the year. We may possibly use one or more of the following pesticides in your school this year:

Parents or guardians may request prior notification of planned pesticide applications per Education code 17612, unless an emergency condition exists (*Ed Code 17609(c) defines "Emergency conditions" as any circumstance in which the school district designee deems that the immediate use of a pesticide is necessary to protect the health and safety of pupils, staff or other persons, or the school site.*

I understand that upon request the school is required to supply information about the individual pesticide applications at least 72 hours before application, unless an emergency condition exists. I would like to be notified before each pesticide application at the Grizzly Hill Elementary School/Washington School Campus.
