

School Opening Update

The new school year begins on Monday, August 17, 2020, in just a few days!! Are you ready to go? If not, how can we help?

This year the district will open both schools in remote learning. This opening plan is a departure from what we had hoped to offer, as we had wanted to offer both an in-person hybrid and a remote plan. With the demands of opening a hybrid ever increasing, we have decided to go forth and open with the plan that allows teachers to best educate every student. This will be distance learning.

What do you need to do to enroll?

Opening Week Schedule:

Monday, August 17 is Opening Day at GH and WS. Please stop by the school sites and make the initial start of school connection with the school, receive your class specific instructions and your chromebook, if needed.

Tuesday - Friday, August 18-21 is Opening Week at GH and WS. During this first week the teaching staff and administrative staff will work together to make sure each student has all they need to begin rigorous, relevant, grade level instruction. This week is to smooth out any bumps in your child's education.

Wednesday will be food distribution day. During the first week of school the district will provide Central Kitchen as we have a contract through then. After the first week, Grizzly Hill will be providing home cooked breakfast and lunch for every student (GH and WS) indicating they want meals. Our food services staff LOVES preparing food for our students. Please sign up!

During the second week of school GH will add, by appointment, wifi computer lab time. WS will already have open time to use the school wifi.

During the third week we anticipate adding some elective time, if possible.
